




Potential Tropical Cyclone Six

** TROPICAL STORM WARNING FOR PUERTO RICO AND U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS **

- Center Location: 15.7N, 62.2W
- About:
 - ~330 miles ESE of Ponce, PR
 - ~90 miles SSE of Guadeloupe
 - Maximum Sustained winds: 35 mph
- Minimum Central Pressure: 1010 mbar
- Movement: WNW at 17 mph

Flooding Rain	Flash Flood WATCH	South/East PR & USVI: 2-3 inches with locally higher amounts Rest of the area: I-2 inches with locally higher amounts	There is a potential for significant amounts of rainfall that could lead to flash flooding, mudslides, and river flooding.	Anywhere in Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands	This Afternoon through Wednesday Night
Tornado	Issued as needed.	Isolated weak tornadoes/waterspouts possible in outer bands.	There is a slight potential for elevated threats from tornadoes and waterspouts. Limited impacts.	Anywhere across Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands	This Afternoon through Early Wednesday Morning
Marine	Tropical Storm WARNING	Seas 7 to 12 feet with occasional seas up to 14 feet.	Dangerous boating, swimming and surfing conditions, as well as localized beach erosion. Life-threatening rip current conditions.	Most of the local waters	This Morning through Wednesday.

Heavy rainfall likely to produce flooding and landslides over the local islands.



Hazardous marine conditions are expected across the local waters.



Tropical-storm-force wind gusts are **expected** across the local waters and the local islands.



Isolated weak tornadoes and/or waterspouts cannot be ruled out.



Storm surge flooding is **not expected**.
